SPA BY MTM, SHANGHAI

Following a minimalism aesthetic, where the space design emphasises extreme leisure and comfort, Spa by MTM was launched in Hong Kong and extended into mainland China where the retail design, inspiring a contemporary, natural, and artistic approach, has been extended into a new 2,000 sq m offer in Shanghai.

Curved wood stripes extend from the main lobby to treatment rooms. An arc ceiling and striped partition enhances the peaceful, comfortable chic, and curved wood shapes express a unique architectural form.

Beyond the lift lobby there is a reception table made of black glass and marble, contrasting with the white bright of the space. To produce a welcome and pleasant environment, seating is clustered by a green wall, while simple wood art is presented on a white wall, with white being the main colour, for purity, freshness and nature.

Subtle lighting provides a considered refinement, with the brightness of the lobby switching to a more serene lower light level in the corridor. The curved-shaped passage, with both sides formed by wood-strip partitions, anticipates the client's desire for calm. Each of the 15 treatment rooms has a soft colour scheme, with delicate details and a simple screen creating a harmonious space.
